5	SECTION 1. Subchapter P, Chapter 42A, Code of Criminal

Procedure, is amended by adding Article 42A.7555 to read as

- 8 Art. 42A.7555. PROCEDURES APPLICABLE TO CERTAIN TECHNICAL
 9 VIOLATIONS. (a) This article applies to any violation of a
 10 condition of community supervision by a defendant on community
- 11 supervision for a nonviolent offense that is punishable as a state
- 12 jail felony or a felony of the third degree, other than a violation
- 13 that involves:

follows:

- (1) being arrested for, charged with, or convicted of
- 15 an offense;

- (2) failing to report to a supervision officer as
- 17 directed for 180 days or more; or
- 18 (3) contacting the victim of the offense for which the
- 19 <u>defendant was placed on community supervision.</u>
- 20 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, if
- 21 <u>after a hearing under Article 42A.751(d) the judge determines the</u>
- 22 defendant violated only a condition of community supervision to
- 23 which this article applies, the judge may not revoke the
- 24 defendant's community supervision but may continue, extend, or

- 1 modify the community supervision. If the judge requires the
- 2 defendant to serve a term of confinement based on a violation to
- 3 which this article applies, the term may not exceed 180 days.
- 4 SECTION 2. Chapter 509, Government Code, is amended by
- 5 adding Section 509.018 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 509.018. DISTRIBUTION OF COST SAVINGS RELATING TO
- 7 TECHNICAL VIOLATIONS. Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 8 chapter, the Texas Department of Criminal Justice shall adopt
- 9 policies and procedures to:
- 10 (1) determine the cost savings to the Texas Department
- 11 of Criminal Justice realized through continuing, extending, or
- 12 modifying the community supervision of a defendant who commits a
- 13 technical violation as provided by Article 42A.7555, Code of
- 14 Criminal Procedure, instead of revoking the defendant's community
- 15 <u>supervision; and</u>
- 16 (2) provide:
- 17 (A) one-third of the cost savings described by
- 18 Subdivision (1) to the division to be allocated to individual
- 19 departments and used for the same purpose that state aid is used
- 20 under Section 509.011; and
- 21 (B) one-third of the cost savings described by
- 22 Subdivision (1) to the division to be used for making payments to
- 23 <u>departments in accordance with Section 509.0071(e).</u>
- SECTION 3. Article 42A.7555, Code of Criminal Procedure, as
- 25 added by this Act, applies to a person on community supervision on
- 26 or after the effective date of this Act, regardless of whether the
- 27 person was placed on community supervision before, on, or after the

- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
