(a) The board 8 9 shall propose rules under this subchapter to create abbreviated educator preparation programs for a candidate seeking: 10 11 (1) a certification to teach courses in marketing; and 12 (2) a certification to teach courses in health 13 science. 14 (b) In proposing rules for educator preparation programs under this section, the board shall ensure that each program at a 15 16 minimum requires 200 hours of coursework or training. SECTION 2. The State Board for Educator Certification shall 17 propose rules establishing standards to govern the approval and 18 renewal of approval of educator preparation programs 19 for 20 certification in marketing and certification in health science. 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
