AN ACT

2 relating to the authority of the Texas Facilities Commission over

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2166.052, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsections (d), (e), (f), (g),
- 7 (h), and (i) to read as follows:
- 8 (b) The commission may not sell or otherwise dispose of real
- 9 property of the state except:
- 10 (1) for real property located in the Capitol Complex,
- 11 by specific authority:

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- 12 $\underline{\text{(A)}}$ [\frac{\left(1)}{\right)}] granted by the legislature if the
- 13 legislature is in session; or
- (B) $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$ granted jointly by the governor and the
- 15 Legislative Budget Board if the legislature is not in session; or
- 16 (2) for real property of the state other than the
- 17 property described by Subdivision (1):
- 18 (A) by specific authority granted by the
- 19 <u>legislature if the legislature is in session; or</u>
- 20 (B) subject to Subsection (e), through formal
- 21 notification to the governor and the Legislative Budget Board if
- 22 the legislature is not in session.
- 23 (d) When considering a sale of real property of the state
- 24 subject to Subsection (b)(2), the commission shall submit a formal

- 1 notification of the intent to sell the property to:
- 2 <u>(1)</u> the governor;
- 3 (2) the Legislative Budget Board; and
- 4 (3) each state senator and representative in whose
- 5 district the property is located.
- 6 (e) The governor may disapprove the sale of real property of
- 7 the state subject to Subsection (b)(2) by providing written notice
- 8 of the disapproval to the commission not later than the 90th day
- 9 after the date the governor receives the formal notification
- 10 required by Subsection (d).
- 11 (f) On request by the commission, the General Land Office
- 12 shall negotiate and close a sale of real property of the state under
- 13 this section on behalf of the commission using procedures
- 14 established in Section 31.158(c), Natural Resources Code, except
- 15 the land office is not required to offer the School Land Board the
- 16 first option to purchase the real property.
- 17 (g) Each transfer of an interest in real property of the
- 18 state under this section must be made by an instrument signed by the
- 19 executive director of the commission and the governor.
- 20 (h) The proceeds from the sale, lease, or other disposition
- 21 of real property of the state under this section shall be deposited
- 22 to the Texas capital trust fund established under Chapter 2201 and
- 23 dedicated to the acquisition, construction, repair, and
- 24 improvement of state facilities. Before depositing proceeds in the
- 25 <u>fund</u>, the commission may recover from the proceeds all amounts
- 26 spent by the commission for management, acquisition, and
- 27 disposition expenses.
