- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 534.053(g), Government Code, as amended
- 7 by Chapters 837 (S.B. 200), 946 (S.B. 277), and 1117 (H.B. 3523),
- 8 Acts of the 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 2015, is reenacted
- 9 and amended to read as follows:
- 10 (g) On January 1, 2029 [the one-year anniversary of the date
- 11 the commission completes implementation of the transition required
- 12 under Section 534.202]:
- 13 (1) the advisory committee is abolished; and
- 14 (2) this section expires.
- SECTION 2. Section 534.054(b), Government Code, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 (b) This section expires January 1, 2029 [2026].
- SECTION 3. Section 534.106(a), Government Code, is amended
- 19 to read as follows:
- 20 (a) The commission [and the department] shall implement any
- 21 pilot programs established under this subchapter not later than
- 22 September 1, 2022 [2017].
- SECTION 4. Section 534.111, Government Code, is amended to
- 24 read as follows:

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- 1 Sec. 534.111. CONCLUSION OF PILOT PROGRAMS;
- 2 EXPIRATION. On September 1, 2024 [2019]:
- 3 (1) each pilot program established under this
- 4 subchapter that is still in operation must conclude; and
- 5 (2) this subchapter expires.

- 6 SECTION 5. Section 534.201(b), Government Code, is amended 7 to read as follows:
- 8 On September 1, 2025 [2020], the commission shall transition the provision of Medicaid benefits to individuals to 9 whom this section applies to the $\underline{STAR+PLUS}$ [$\underline{STAR+PLUS}$] Medicaid 10 managed care program delivery model or the most appropriate 11 12 integrated capitated managed care program delivery model, as determined by the commission based on cost-effectiveness and the 13 experience of the STAR+PLUS [STAR + PLUS] Medicaid managed care 14 15 program in providing basic attendant and habilitation services and of the pilot programs established under Subchapter C, subject to 16
- SECTION 6. Section 534.202(b), Government Code, is amended
- (b) After implementing the transition required by Section 20 534.201, on September 1, 2027 [2021], the commission shall 21 transition the provision of Medicaid benefits to individuals to 22 whom this section applies to the $\underline{STAR+PLU}S$ [\underline{STAR} + \underline{PLUS}] Medicaid 23 24 managed care program delivery model or the most appropriate integrated capitated managed care program delivery model, as 25 26 determined by the commission based on cost-effectiveness and the experience of the transition of Texas home living (TxHmL) waiver 27

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- 1 program recipients to a managed care program delivery model under
- 2 Section 534.201, subject to Subsections (c)(1) and (g).
- 3 SECTION 7. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 4 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 5 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 6 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 7 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 8 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 9 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
