3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 825, Health and Safety Code, is amended
5	by adding Subchapter D to read as follows:
6	SUBCHAPTER D. CONTROL OF PREDATORY ANIMALS
7	Sec. 825.051. MUNICIPAL CONTROL OF COYOTES. A municipality
8	with a population density of more than 2,500 persons per square
9	mile may capture, relocate, or euthanize a coyote located within
10	the municipality or the municipality's extraterritorial
11	jurisdiction. The municipality may request assistance from Texas
12	Wildlife Services to capture, relocate, or euthanize a coyote.
13	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
14	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
15	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
16	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
17	Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
