4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 2002, Insurance Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 2002.103 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 2002.103. REQUIRED DISCLOSURE REGARDING COVERAGE
8	LIMITS FOR WATER DAMAGE. (a) In this section, "residential
9	property insurance" has the meaning assigned by Section 2301.002.
10	(b) Before accepting any premium or fee for a residential
11	property insurance policy, an agent or insurer, including a county
12	mutual insurance company, must make the following disclosure,
13	orally and in writing, to the applicant or insured:
14	WARNING: THIS POLICY CONTAINS IMPORTANT LIMITS ON COVERAGE FOR
15	WATER DAMAGE. WATER DAMAGE POLICY LIMITS CAN BE FOUND AT (PAGE OR
16	ENDORSEMENT). CAREFULLY REVIEW THESE LIMITS.
17	(c) Before accepting any premium or fee for a residential
18	property insurance policy, an agent or insurer, including a county
19	mutual insurance company, must receive a copy of the disclosure
20	described by Subsection (b) that is signed by the applicant or
21	insured.
22	(d) The agent or insurer shall require the applicant or
23	insured to confirm contemporaneously in writing the provision of
24	oral disclosure pursuant to Subsection (b).

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1 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an insurance policy that 2 is delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 3 2020. A policy delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before 4 January 1, 2020, is governed by the law as it existed immediately 5 before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in 6 effect for that purpose.

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
