BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 511, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 511.0098 to read as follows: 1-20 1-21

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for those services. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
