- 19 STATIONS IN FLOODPLAIN. (a) In this section, "local flood map" has
- 20 the meaning assigned by Section 16.501, Water Code.
- 21 (b) The commission shall consider a local flood map in
- 22 determining whether to issue a permit for a municipal solid waste
- 23 landfill or transfer station to be located in a floodplain.
- SECTION 3. Section 361.1235, Health and Safety Code, as
- 25 added by this Act, applies only to an application for a municipal
- 26 solid waste permit that is filed with the Texas Commission on
- 27 Environmental Quality on or after the effective date of this Act.

- 1 An application for a municipal solid waste permit that is pending on
- 2 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at
- 3 the time the application was filed, and the former law is continued
- 4 in effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
