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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the consideration of floodplain maps in the permitting of certain solid waste facilities. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 16, Water Code, is amended by adding Subchapter L to read as follows: 6 SUBCHAPTER L. FLOODPLAIN MAPPING 7 Sec. 16.501. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter: 8 (1) "Local flood map" means a map created and 9 certified under this subchapter. 10 11 (2) "Local floodplain manager" means the individual 12 responsible for carrying out a local government's floodplain studies and mapping programs of floodplains, flood-prone areas, and 13 flood-risk zones under Section 16.316. 14 (3) "National flood map" means a map approved for use 15 16 in the National Flood Insurance Program. (4) "Political subdivision" has the meaning assigned 17 by Section 16.313. 18 Sec. 16.502. LOCAL FLOOD MAP. A local floodplain manager 19 who has information regarding a floodplain, flood-prone area, or 20 flood-risk zone in the manager's political subdivision that is more 21 recent than the information in the national flood map used in the 22 23 political subdivision may deliver to the board: (1) a local flood map that represents the more recent 24

2	(2) information relevant to the creation of the local
3	flood map; and
4	(3) a sworn statement that the information represented
5	in the local flood map is accurate to the best of the local
6	floodplain manager's knowledge.
7	Sec. 16.503. CERTIFICATION AND PUBLICATION OF LOCAL FLOOD
8	MAP. On receipt of an updated local flood map and sworn statement
9	under Section 16.502, the board shall certify the map and make it
10	available on the board's Internet website.
11	Sec. 16.504. LIABILITY. A local floodplain manager is not
12	personally liable for damages arising from the use of information
13	in a local flood map.
14	Sec. 16.505. RULES. The board shall adopt rules to
15	implement this subchapter.
16	SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 361, Health and Safety
17	Code, is amended by adding Section 361.1235 to read as follows:
18	Sec. 361.1235. MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE LANDFILLS AND TRANSFER
19	STATIONS IN FLOODPLAIN. (a) In this section, "local flood map" has
20	the meaning assigned by Section 16.501, Water Code.
21	(b) The commission shall consider a local flood map in
22	determining whether to issue a permit for a municipal solid waste
23	landfill or transfer station to be located in a floodplain.
24	SECTION 3. Section 361.1235, Health and Safety Code, as
25	added by this Act, applies only to an application for a municipal
26	solid waste permit that is filed with the Texas Commission on
27	Environmental Quality on or after the effective date of this Act.

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1 An application for a municipal solid waste permit that is pending on 2 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect at 3 the time the application was filed, and the former law is continued 4 in effect for that purpose.

5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
