| 5 | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: |
| 6 | SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the Cultural Inclusion |
| 7 | Act. |
| 8 | SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 28, Education Code, is |
| 9 | amended by adding Sec. 28.021 to read as follows: |
| 10 | Sec. 28.021. INSTRUCTION REGARDING CULTURALLY INCLUSIVE |
| 11 | CURRICULUM. |
| 12 | (a) In this section: |
| 13 | (1) "Board" means the State Board of Education |
| 14 | (2) "Agency" means the Texas Education Agency. |
| 15 | (b) The board, agency, and stakeholders shall enter into a |
| 16 | memorandum of understanding that establishes the respective |
| 17 | responsibilities in developing instruction, including curriculum |
| 18 | and instructional modules, on culturally inclusive curriculum |
| 19 | reflecting the cultural, linguistic and religious diversity of |
| 20 | society. The instruction must include information regarding: |
| 21 | (1) Fostering each child's sense of self-identity; |
| 22 | (2) Fostering acceptance of diversity among people by |
| 23 | allowing children to ask about and explore the differences; |
| 24 | (3) Encouraging critical thinking about bias by |

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- 1 helping children to identify acts of discrimination and stereotypic
- 2 images in their world;
- 3 (4) Encouraging empathy towards others; and
- 4 (5) Fostering each child's ability to stand up for
- 5 themselves and others in the face of bias.
- 6 (c) In developing the instruction under this section, the
- 7 board and the agency may consult with any interested party,
- 8 including a volunteer work group convened for the purpose of making
- 9 recommendations regarding the instruction.
- 10 (d) Before finalizing any instruction under this section,
- 11 the board and the agency shall provide a reasonable period for
- 12 public comment.
- 13 (e) Subject to rules adopted by the board, a school district
- 14 or open-enrollment charter school may tailor the instruction
- 15 <u>developed under this section as appropriate for the district's or</u>
- 16 school 's community. In tailoring the instruction, the district or
- 17 school shall solicit input from local law enforcement agencies,
- 18 driver training schools, and the community.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
