## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to a study and report on the optimum water level of Falcon
- 3 Lake.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) The Texas Commission on Environmental
- 6 Quality and the Texas Parks and Wildlife Commission shall study and
- 7 report on the optimum water level of Falcon Lake.
- 8 (b) In conducting the study the commissions shall include a
- 9 written report that includes:
- 10 (1) an estimate of the optimum water level for
- 11 recreational fishing;
- 12 (2) the factors that contribute to the rise and drop in
- 13 water levels;
- 14 (3) recommendations on how to maintain the optimum
- 15 water level for recreational fishing on Falcon Lake.
- 16 (c) Not later than December 1, 2020, the commission shall
- 17 submit to the governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker of the
- 18 house of representatives the report prepared under Subsection (b)
- 19 of this section.
- SECTION 2. This Act expires September 1, 2021.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
