## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the amount of a tax imposed by the Sutton County
- 3 Underground Water Conservation District.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 8886.201(b), Special District Local
- 6 Laws Code, as effective April 1, 2019, is amended to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (b) On approval of the majority of the voters in an election
- 9 called for that purpose, the district may impose an ad valorem tax
- 10 to pay the principal of and interest on bonds and to maintain the
- 11 district. [The tax approved under this subsection may not exceed
- 12 five cents on each \$100 of assessed valuation.
- SECTION 2. Section 8886.201(c), Special District Local
- 14 Laws Code, as effective April 1, 2019, is repealed.
- 15 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 16 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 17 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 18 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 19 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 20 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 21 Government Code.
- 22 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 23 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 24 Environmental Quality.

- 1 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 2 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 3 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 4 representatives within the required time.
- 5 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 6 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 7 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 8 and accomplished.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
