1 WHEREAS, S. Javaid Anwar is being recognized as the Top Hand
2 of 2018 at the annual awards banquet of the Permian Basin Petroleum
3 Association on January 17, 2019; and

4 WHEREAS, Born in Karachi, Pakistan, Mr. Anwar was raised by a
5 single mother who labored hard to provide him with opportunities
6 for advancement; he came to the United States to study petroleum
7 engineering at the University of Wyoming, where he helped put
8 himself through school by holding jobs as a busboy and a
9 construction worker; and

10 WHEREAS, After graduating in 1976, Mr. Anwar worked for oil
11 companies in the Panhandle and Houston before settling in Midland
12 to start his own business; in 1984, he drilled his first well near
13 Kermit, and today he is the owner and president of Midland Energy,
14 Petroplex Energy, and Western T. Corporation, as well as an
15 influential and respected advocate for the oil and gas industry;

17 WHEREAS, In addition to his professional success, Mr. Anwar
18 has found time to give back as a member of the Texas Higher
19 Education Coordinating Board, the Texas Lieutenant Governor's
20 Energy Council, and the board of the George W. Bush Childhood Home;
21 he is also a lifetime member of the Society of Petroleum Engineers,
22 and he has generously supported the Cockrell School's Engineering
23 Education and Research Center at The University of Texas; and

24 WHEREAS, This distinguished gentleman's myriad accolades

1 include the Philanthropist of the Year Award from the Permian Basin
2 chapter of the Association of Fundraising Professionals, the MS
3 Hope Award from the National Multiple Sclerosis Society,
4 humanitarian awards from the Pakistan Citizens Foundation and the
5 Human Development Foundation, the Golden Hammer Award from Midland
6 Habitat for Humanity, the Outstanding Businessman and Entrepreneur
7 Award from the Pakistan Chamber of Commerce-USA, the Businessman of
8 the Year Award from the South Asian Chamber of Commerce in Houston,
9 and the Man of the Year Award from Safeer e Pakistan; and

10 WHEREAS, In all his endeavors, Mr. Anwar enjoys the love and
11 support of his wife, Vicky, and their two children, Leslie and Ryan;
