HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, Proud residents of Midland and Odessa are gathering
- 2 in Austin February 4-6, 2019, to celebrate Midland-Odessa Days at
- 3 the State Capitol; and
- WHEREAS, Set only 20 miles apart in the ranching and oil
- 5 country of West Texas, these vibrant Texas cities got their start as
- 6 stops on the Texas and Pacific Railway in the 1880s; by 1890,
- 7 Midland was one of the most important centers for shipping cattle in
- 8 Texas; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Odessa began its rapid growth with the discovery of
- 10 oil in the Permian Basin in the 1920s, and by 1929, Midland was home
- 11 to 36 oil companies; today, Midland continues to be the financial
- 12 and administrative capital of the Permian Basin, while Odessa
- 13 remains the center for the region's oil processing and
- 14 distribution; and
- WHEREAS, Odessa and Midland boast many fine historical and
- 16 cultural attractions; in Odessa, the Presidential Archives &
- 17 Leadership Library is the only museum in the nation dedicated to the
- 18 history of the office of the presidency; the families of both Bush
- 19 presidents have called Midland and Odessa home, and the archive
- 20 features a restored house where the Bush family once resided; and
- 21 WHEREAS, The Ellen Noël Art Museum, one of only two
- 22 Smithsonian affiliates in Texas, features world-class exhibits
- 23 year-round, and the Parker House Ranching Museum evokes the way of
- 24 life of a prominent Texas ranching family; the Haley Memorial

- 1 Library & History Center houses the first bell to hang in the Alamo,
- 2 as well as vast resources of oral and written history about the
- 3 cowboy; and
- WHEREAS, Situated between Midland and Odessa is the Wagner
- 5 Noël Performing Arts Center, a state-of-the-art facility boasting a
- 6 total of 2,000 seats between its theater and recital hall, which
- 7 brings in myriad shows to impress a variety of audiences; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Visitors and residents alike enjoy the Stonehenge
- 9 replica on the campus of The University of Texas of the Permian
- 10 Basin, as well as live productions at the replica of Shakespeare's
- 11 Globe Theatre on the campus of Odessa College; furthermore, the
- 12 Midland Festival Ballet, the Midland-Odessa Symphony and Chorale,
- 13 and the award-winning Midland Community Theatre offer live
- 14 performances that inspire and entertain; and
- WHEREAS, The White-Pool house is the first residential home
- 16 in Odessa and proudly displays items from both the White and Pool
- 17 families; also located in Odessa and enjoyed by more than 10,000
- 18 visitors every year is the nation's second-largest meteor crater
- 19 and adjoining museum; and
- WHEREAS, Midland's Museum of the Southwest offers displays of
- 21 the art and archaeology of the American Southwest, as well as the
- 22 winning Kentucky Derby history of one of Midland's prominent
- 23 families; the interactive exhibits of the Permian Basin Petroleum
- 24 Museum present the geology and history of oil while helping to
- 25 inspire entrepreneurs of the future; and
- 26 WHEREAS, Odessa features the Chris Kyle Memorial Plaza, which
- 27 honors the former Navy SEAL who was born in Odessa, and also pays

- 1 tribute to past, current, and future veterans who have served our
- 2 country so unselfishly; the Midland Army Air Field Museum preserves
- 3 the history of the largest bombardier training school in World War
- 4 II and also highlights the contributions that West Texans made to
- 5 the war effort; and
- 6 WHEREAS, For more than a century, the dynamic cities of
- 7 Midland and Odessa have been at the economic and cultural hub of
- 8 West Texas, and their citizens continue to celebrate their rich
- 9 history as they work hard to build a prosperous future; now,
- 10 therefore, be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the 86th Legislature of the State of Texas
- 12 hereby recognize February 4-6, 2019, as Midland-Odessa Days at the
- 13 State Capitol and extend to the visiting delegation best wishes for
- 14 an informative and enjoyable stay in Austin.
