CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Frank Salvato is retiring as assistant city manager 2 of Midland on March 31, 2019, drawing to a close an outstanding 3 career in public service that has spanned nearly four decades; and

WHEREAS, A former middle school teacher, Mr. Salvato began his career in municipal government in 1980 as a code enforcement officer and health inspector for Fort Stockton, and he later earned promotion to assistant city manager; in the ensuing years, he served as city manager of Llano, Taylor, and Bee Cave; and

9 WHEREAS, In October 2014, Mr. Salvato returned to West Texas to take on the role of assistant city manager of Midland, and he has 10 11 since ably overseen the departments of development, engineering, 12 communication and information, and airports; drawing on his years of experience and expertise in municipal management, he supported 13 14 an update to the city's comprehensive plan and zoning ordinance, helped recruit additional retailers to increase sales tax, worked 15 16 on residential and commercial development agreements, and promoted enhancement projects for Midland International Air and Space Port 17 and Midland Airpark; he also assisted with planning for street 18 improvements and extensions, and he played an instrumental role in 19 20 the successful passage of a \$100 million bond for road repairs; and

21 WHEREAS, Mr. Salvato holds a bachelor's degree from Angelo 22 State University, an associate degree in criminal justice from 23 Midland College, and a master's degree in political science and 24 public administration from Sul Ross State University; he has
