CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Members of the Texas Court Reporters Association are  
2 celebrating Texas Court Reporting and Captioning Week from February  
3 9 to 16, 2019; and

4 WHEREAS, Since the 1930s, the association has worked to  
5 advance the field of stenographic reporting through education and  
6 advocacy; TCRA is dedicated to promoting the accuracy and  
7 impartiality that are the hallmarks of the courtroom professional,  
8 and the group provides its members with a valuable forum for

11 achieve different levels of certification; they develop typing
