CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, On January 22, 1973, the majority of the members of
2 the United States Supreme Court ruled, in *Roe v. Wade*, that abortion
3 was a right secured by the U.S. Constitution; and

4 WHEREAS, Since that fateful day, more than 58 million unborn
5 children have perished; now, therefore, be it

6 RESOLVED, That the 86th Legislature of the State of Texas
7 hereby designate January 22 as the Day of Tears and encourage the
8 citizens of the Lone Star State to lower their flags to half-staff
9 on that day; and, be it further

10 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of Section
11 [391.004\(d\)](#), Government Code, this designation remain in effect
12 until the 10th anniversary of the date that this resolution is
13 finally passed by the legislature.
