- 16 a warning and threw himself on the grenade to protect his comrades
- 17 from the blast; fortunately, it failed to detonate, and he was able
- 18 to resume treating casualties; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Demonstrating extraordinary courage in the line of
- 20 duty, Donald Ballard fulfilled the highest ideals of the United
- 21 States armed forces, and he has earned the lasting admiration of a
- 22 grateful nation; now, therefore, be it
