6 individuals who have earned the Medal of Honor, the nation's

10 WHEREAS, A veteran of the U.S. Army, Michael Fitzmaurice

11 served during the Vietnam War as a specialist fourth class with

12 Troop D, 2nd Squadron, 17th Cavalry Regiment, 101st Airborne

13 Division; while he was fighting at Khe Sanh, enemy combatants threw

14 explosive charges into his bunker; without regard for his own

15 safety, he hurled two of the charges out of the bunker and threw

16 himself and his flak vest over the remaining charge, shielding

17 three fellow soldiers from the blast; though seriously wounded and

18 experiencing partial vision loss, he charged out of the bunker and

19 engaged in hand-to-hand combat, selflessly continuing to protect

20 his comrades and refusing medical evacuation; and

21 WHEREAS, Demonstrating extraordinary courage in the line of

22 duty, Michael Fitzmaurice fulfilled the highest ideals of the

23 United States armed forces, and he has earned the lasting

24 admiration of a grateful nation; now, therefore, be it
