- 5 local schools, students learn to appreciate the workings of our
- 6 representative democracy, and they gain a better understanding of
- 7 the legislative processes and the importance of effective public
- 8 policy; moreover, by engaging in meaningful conversations with
- 9 young constituents, legislators can get a fresh perspective on the
- 10 day-to-day realities of public schools in the Lone Star State; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Programs that promote a stronger and more
- 12 collaborative relationship between policy makers and their local
- 13 school districts greatly benefit our communities and the state as a
- 14 whole; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the 86th Legislature of the State of Texas
- 16 hereby designate the second Tuesday in October as Legislators in
- 17 Schools Day; and, be it further
- 18 RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of Section
- 19 391.004(d), Government Code, this designation remain in effect
- 20 until the 10th anniversary of the date this resolution is finally
- 21 passed by the legislature.
