- 11 Botts, Andrews, and Shepherd in Houston and then moved to Roswell,

- 13 Hervey, Dow & Hinkle; during his subsequent tenure with Stubbeman,
- 14 McRae, Sealy, Laughlin & Browder in Midland, he was engaged by
- 15 British Petroleum to work on the Prudhoe Bay Unit Agreement and Unit
- 16 Operating Agreements; he and five colleagues left the firm in 1974
- 17 to establish Cotton Bledsoe Tighe & Morrow, which grew to become the
- 18 Permian Basin's largest firm, with 35 attorneys; and
- 19 WHEREAS, Mr. Bledsoe was among the first Texas lawyers to
- 20 earn certification as a specialist in oil, gas, and mineral law, and
- 21 he has served on the Texas Board of Legal Specialization; over the
- 22 years, he has been much in demand as a speaker and writer on
- 23 industry topics; the Texas Bar Foundation presented him with the
- 24 Outstanding 50 Year Lawyer Award in 2008 to recognize his long
