## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

- 1 WHEREAS, For well over a century, Americans have set aside a
- 2 time to honor those members of its military forces who have died in
- 3 this country's service; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Originally called Decoration Day, this special
- 5 remembrance was first observed in 1868, when flowers were placed on
- 6 the graves of Union and Confederate soldiers; by the end of the 19th
- 7 century, Memorial Day ceremonies were being held on May 30
- 8 throughout the nation, and in 1971 Congress designated the last
- 9 Monday in May as Memorial Day; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Legions of Americans have stepped forward to serve
- 11 their country in times of conflict, and more than a million have
- 12 made the ultimate sacrifice; they "gave the last full measure of
- 13 devotion" on their native soil, in foreign lands, and on seas around
- 14 the world; today, we pause to remember with fresh sorrow all Texans
- 15 who have been slain in combat as members of the United States
- 16 military, and we acknowledge the profound loss sustained by the
- 17 families they have left behind; and
- 18 WHEREAS, In memorial ceremonies around the nation, Americans
- 19 reflect on their heritage and recognize the extreme sacrifices made
- 20 by those who serve in the armed forces of this country; now,
- 21 therefore, be it
- 22 RESOLVED by the 86th Texas Legislature, That the Senate and
- 23 House of Representatives of the State of Texas meet in a joint
- 24 memorial session in the Hall of the House of Representatives on

- 2 Service to pay tribute to all members of the U.S. military killed in
- 3 the line of duty and to honor especially the patriotic sons and

- 5 it further
- 6 RESOLVED, That the Honorable Greg Abbott, Governor of Texas,
- 7 all Texas state officials, and the family members of those killed in
- 8 the service of this country be, and hereby are, invited to attend
- 9 the joint memorial session; and, be it further
- 10 RESOLVED, That Memorial Day 2019 be commemorated and that the
- 11 contributions of all the men and women who have served our great
- 12 country be recognized.
