Host City Program acknowledges the heroism and sacrifice of

10 WHEREAS, A U.S. Army veteran of the Vietnam War, Major Brady

distinguished himself through his skill and gallantry in flying

ambulance helicopters into enemy territory to rescue 51 severely

wounded men in the span of one day; he was forced to navigate

through dense fog and smoke, and he continued with the mission

15 despite the fact that two other aircraft had been shot down while

16 attempting to reach a particularly perilous landing zone; following

17 three trips, he was issued a request to land in an enemy minefield

18 where a platoon of American soldiers was trapped, and he managed to

19 fly six seriously injured patients out of the area even after a mine

20 detonated next to his helicopter; many of those who he evacuated on

21 that day would have perished if not for his efforts; and

WHEREAS, Demonstrating extraordinary courage in the line of

23 duty, Patrick Brady fulfilled the highest ideals of the United

24 States armed forces, and he has earned the lasting admiration of a
