A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment providing for the issuance of
- 2 general obligation bonds by the Texas Public Finance Authority to
- 3 fund research, treatment, and access to services in this state for
- 4 behavioral health, mental health, and substance use and addiction
- 5 issues.
- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 8 adding Section 68 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 68. (a) The legislature by general law may authorize
- 10 the Texas Public Finance Authority or its successor to provide for,
- 11 issue, and sell general obligation bonds of the State of Texas and
- 12 to enter into related credit agreements for the purpose of funding
- 13 programs:
- 14 (1) to research behavioral health issues generally,
- 15 including causes of behavioral health issues, public health trends
- 16 and strategies regarding behavioral health issues, and new
- 17 behavioral health treatments, interventions, and other solutions;
- 18 (2) to research substance use and addiction issues,
- 19 including genetic determinates of addiction, identification of and
- 20 mitigation of substance use and addiction risk factors, addiction
- 21 recovery, pain management strategies, and prescription practices;
- 22 (3) to research behavioral health and mental health
- 23 <u>issues affecting children and adolescents</u>, including unidentified
- 24 and untreated mental illness, involvement in the juvenile justice

- 1 system, and suicide prevention; and
- 2 (4) to address the shortage of mental health
- 3 professionals in this state, including programs to increase access
- 4 to mental health professionals in rural areas of the state,
- 5 programs to increase the use of telemedicine in the treatment of
- 6 behavioral health or mental health issues, and programs to provide
- 7 loan repayment assistance and other funding for mental health
- 8 professionals, including physicians and advanced practice nurses
- 9 trained in the prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of mental
- 10 illness in children and adolescents.
- 11 (b) Proceeds from the sale of the bonds shall be deposited
- 12 in separate funds or accounts, as provided by general law, in the
- 13 state treasury to be used by the Health and Human Services
- 14 Commission or its successor to provide grants to public or private
- 15 institutions of higher education in this state or other state
- 16 agencies or government entities for the purposes provided by
- 17 Subsection (a) of this section.
- 18 (c) The bond proceeds may be used to pay the costs of issuing
- 19 the bonds and any administrative expense related to the bonds.
- 20 (d) While any of the bonds or interest on the bonds
- 21 authorized by this section is outstanding and unpaid, from the
- 22 <u>first money coming into the state treasury in each fiscal year not</u>
- 23 otherwise appropriated by this constitution, an amount sufficient
- 24 to pay the principal of and interest on bonds that mature or become
- 25 due during the fiscal year and to make payments that become due
- 26 under a related credit agreement during the fiscal year is
- 27 appropriated, less the amount in the sinking fund at the close of

- 1 the previous fiscal year.
- 2 (e) Bonds issued under this section, after approval by the
- 3 attorney general, registration by the comptroller of public
- 4 accounts, and delivery to the purchasers, are incontestable and are
- 5 general obligations of the State of Texas under this constitution.
- 6 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 7 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019.
- 8 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 9 proposition: "The constitutional amendment providing for the
- 10 issuance of general obligation bonds by the Texas Public Finance
- 11 Authority to fund research, treatment, and access to services in
- 12 this state for behavioral health, mental health, and substance use
- 13 and addiction issues."
