A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to provide for a temporary local option exemption from ad valorem
- 3 taxation of a portion of the appraised value of certain property
- 4 damaged by a disaster and to provide for reimbursement of a
- 5 political subdivision by the state for refunds the political

- 7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 2, Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is
- 9 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 10 <u>(e) The Legislature by general law may provide that a person</u>
- 11 who owns property located in an area declared by the governor to be
- 12 <u>a disaster area following a disaster is entitled to a temporary</u>
- 13 exemption from ad valorem taxation by a political subdivision of a
- 14 portion of the appraised value of that property if the exemption is
- 15 adopted by the governing body of the political subdivision. The
- 16 Legislature by general law may prescribe the method of determining
- 17 the amount of the exemption authorized by this subsection and the
- 18 duration of the exemption and may provide additional eligibility
- 19 requirements for the exemption. Notwithstanding any other
- 20 provision of this constitution, the Legislature by general law may
- 21 <u>authorize</u> the use of state money to reimburse a political
- 22 subdivision for a refund paid by the political subdivision to a
- 23 person as a result of the exemption authorized by this subsection.
- 24 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be

- 1 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019.
- 2 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 3 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 4 legislature to provide for a temporary local option exemption from
- 5 ad valorem taxation of a portion of the appraised value of certain
- 6 property damaged by a disaster and to provide for reimbursement of a
- 7 political subdivision by the state for refunds the political
- 8 subdivision pays to taxpayers as a result of the exemption."
