## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to dedicate net revenue from
- 2 the state lottery to support educational programs that benefit
- 3 classroom teaching in the state's public schools and to prohibit
- 4 certain lottery advertisements and promotions.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 47, Article III, Texas Constitution, is
- 7 amended by amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (f) to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 (e) The Legislature by general law may authorize the State
- 10 to operate lotteries and may authorize the State to enter into a
- 11 contract with one or more legal entities that will operate
- 12 lotteries on behalf of the State. All money received by the State
- 13 from the operation of lotteries, other than amounts paid for
- 14 administrative costs, lottery prizes, and unclaimed lottery
- 15 prizes, is dedicated to and may be expended only for the enrichment
- of educational programs of the State's public primary and secondary
- 17 schools and only for items that directly benefit classroom
- 18 teaching, including teacher compensation and the acquisition of
- 19 textbooks and educational supplies, materials, equipment, and
- 20 <u>services.</u>
- 21 (f) The State, a legal entity contracting with the State to
- 22 operate lotteries authorized by Subsection (e) of this section, or
- 23 <u>a holder of a license issued by the State related to the operation</u>
- 24 of a lottery authorized by that subsection may not sponsor an

- 1 advertisement or promotion that encourages or attempts to influence
- 2 <u>a person to purchase a lottery ticket by stating the revenue</u>
- 3 generated from the ticket sale will be used to support or provide
- 4 additional money for the State's public primary or secondary
- 5 schools.
- 6 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 7 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019.
- 8 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 9 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to dedicate net revenue
- 10 from the state lottery to support educational programs that benefit
- 11 classroom teaching in the state's public schools and to prohibit
- 12 advertisements and promotions that state the revenue generated by
- 13 the sale of lottery tickets is used to financially assist public
- 14 schools."
