A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature

- 6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
- 8 adding Section 1-w to read as follows:
- 9 <u>Sec. 1-w.</u> (a) The legislature by general law may exempt
- 10 from ad valorem taxation by one or more political subdivisions of
- 11 this state property located near a public school or within a
- 12 <u>municipal management district created under general or special law</u>
- 13 to accomplish the purposes of Sections 52 and 52-a, Article III, and
- 14 Section 59, Article XVI, of this constitution that is owned by a
- 15 person for the purpose of building low-income housing on the
- 16 property.
- 17 (b) The legislature may provide additional eligibility
- 18 requirements for an exemption authorized by this section.
- 19 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 20 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019.
- 21 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 22 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 23 legislature to exempt from ad valorem taxation by one or more
- 24 political subdivisions of this state property located near a public
