A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment dedicating the net revenue 2 from any tax on the sale or use of cannabis or marijuana to public 3 education.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by

6 adding Section 32 to read as follows:

Sec. 32. Subject to legislative appropriation, allocation, and direction, the net revenue remaining after the payment of refunds allowed by law and expenses of collection derived from a tax on the sale or use of cannabis or marijuana may be used only for the support and maintenance of an efficient system of public free schools.

13 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be 14 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019. 15 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the 16 proposition: "The constitutional amendment dedicating the net 17 revenue from any tax on the sale or use of cannabis or marijuana to 18 public education."
