A JOINT RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 65(a), Article XVI, Texas Constitution, 5 is amended to read as follows: 6

7 This section applies to the following offices: District (a) Clerks; County Clerks; County Judges; [Judges of the County Courts 8 at Law, County Criminal Courts, County Probate Courts and County 9 Domestic Relations Courts]; County Treasurers; Criminal District 10 11 Attorneys; County Surveyors; County Commissioners; Justices of the 12 Peace; Sheriffs; Assessors and Collectors of Taxes; District Attorneys; County Attorneys; Public Weighers; and Constables. 13

14 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019. 15 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the 16 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing certain 17 judges to become a candidate for another office without 18 automatically resigning from the office already held." 19
