A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment permitting a person to hold  
2 more than one office as an unpaid municipal judge.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 40, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, is  
5 amended by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

6 (e) Notwithstanding Subsections (a) and (c) of this  
7 section, a person may hold more than one office as an elected or  
8 appointed municipal judge in more than one municipality at the same  
9 time if the person receives no salary or compensation for any office  
10 of municipal judge held by the person.

11 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be  
12 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019.  
13 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the  
14 proposition: "The constitutional amendment permitting a person to  
15 hold more than one office as an unpaid municipal judge."
