C.S.H.J.R. No. 83

A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the state or a
2 municipality or county to donate certain property to the United
3 States to promote border crossing security or international bridge
4 trade corridors, to issue public securities to finance the
5 acquisition or construction of that property, and to use public
6 money to make certain payments related to public-private
7 partnerships.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

9 SECTION 1. Article III, Texas Constitution, is amended by
10 adding Section 52m to read as follows:

11 Sec. 52m. (a) The state or a municipality or county may
12 unconditionally donate to the United States to promote border
13 crossing security or international bridge trade corridors:

14 (1) real property acquired by and improvements to that
15 property acquired or constructed by the state or the municipality
16 or county; and

17 (2) technology or equipment acquired by the state or
18 the municipality or county.

19 (b) For the purposes described by Subsection (a) of this
20 section, the state or a municipality or county may issue public
21 securities as provided under general law for financing public
22 works, without the necessity of further or amendatory legislation,
23 to:

24 (1) finance the acquisition of property described by

1 that subsection or the construction of improvements described by
2 that subsection; or

3 (2) refund or refinance existing debt incurred by the
4 state or the municipality or county to acquire property described
5 by that subsection or to construct improvements described by that
6 subsection.

7 (c) An election is not required to authorize a public
8 security issued under Subsection (b) of this section regardless of
9 whether the public security is payable from ad valorem taxes.

10 (d) The state or a municipality or county may use public
11 money to pay lease payments, service payments, user fees, debt
12 service, or other costs associated with a public-private
13 partnership to establish public works for border crossing security
14 or for international bridge trade corridors.

15 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
16 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019.
17 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
18 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the state
19 or a municipality or county to unconditionally donate to the United
20 States certain property acquired or constructed by the state or the
21 municipality or county to promote border crossing security or
22 international bridge trade corridors, to issue public securities to
23 finance the acquisition or construction of that property, and to
24 use public money to make certain payments related to public-private
25 partnerships establishing public works for those purposes."
