A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment to authorize a local option
- 2 exemption from ad valorem taxation of a portion of the appraised
- 3 value of the residence homesteads of certain volunteer first
- 4 responders.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1-b, Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
- 7 is amended by adding Subsection (r) to read as follows:
- 8 <u>(r)</u> The governing body of a political subdivision may exempt
- 9 from ad valorem taxation an amount not to exceed \$15,000 of the
- 10 appraised value of the residence homestead of a volunteer first
- 11 responder. Where ad valorem tax of a political subdivision has
- 12 previously been pledged for the payment of debt, the taxing
- 13 officers of the political subdivision may continue to levy and
- 14 collect the tax against the value of residence homesteads exempted
- 15 under this subsection until the debt is discharged if the cessation
- of the levy would impair the obligation of the contract by which the
- 17 debt was created. The legislature by general law may define
- 18 "volunteer first responder" for purposes of this subsection and may
- 19 provide additional eligibility requirements for the exemption.
- 20 SECTION 2. The following temporary provision is added to
- 21 the Texas Constitution:
- TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) This temporary provision applies
- 23 to the constitutional amendment proposed by the 86th Legislature,
- 24 Regular Session, 2019, to authorize a local option exemption from

- 1 ad valorem taxation by a taxing unit of a portion of the appraised
- 2 value of the residence homestead of a volunteer first responder.
- 3 (b) The amendment to Section 1-b, Article VIII, of this
- 4 constitution takes effect January 1, 2020, and applies only to ad
- 5 valorem taxes imposed for a tax year beginning on or after that
- 6 date.
- 7 (c) This temporary provision expires January 1, 2021.
- 8 SECTION 3. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 9 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019.
- 10 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 11 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to authorize a local
- 12 option exemption from ad valorem taxation of an amount not to exceed
- 13 \$15,000 of the appraised value of the residence homesteads of
- 14 certain volunteer first responders."
