A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment requiring elections on
- 2 proposed amendments to the Texas Constitution to be held in
- 3 November of even-numbered years.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1(a), Article XVII, Texas Constitution,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The Legislature, at any regular session, or at any
- 8 special session when the matter is included within the purposes for
- 9 which the session is convened, may propose amendments revising the
- 10 Constitution, to be voted upon by the qualified voters for
- 11 statewide offices and propositions, as defined in the Constitution
- 12 and statutes of this State. The date of the elections shall be on
- 13 the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of
- 14 even-numbered years [specified by the Legislature]. The proposal
- 15 for submission must be approved by a vote of two-thirds of all the
- 16 members elected to each House, entered by yeas and nays on the
- 17 journals.
- 18 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 19 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 3, 2020.
- 20 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 21 proposition: "The constitutional amendment requiring elections on
- 22 proposed amendments to the Texas Constitution to be held on the
- 23 first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of even-numbered
- 24 years."
