H.J.R. No. 109

A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
2 to provide for a credit against ad valorem taxes imposed by a school
3 district on the property owned by a business entity that donates
4 money to the district to create or support career and technical
5 education programs or courses.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

7 SECTION 1. Article VIII, Texas Constitution, is amended by
8 adding Section 1-y to read as follows:

9 Sec. 1-y. The legislature by general law may provide for a
10 credit against the ad valorem taxes imposed by a school district on
11 the property owned by a business entity that donates money to the
12 district to create or support career and technical education
13 programs or courses. The legislature may provide eligibility
14 requirements for a credit authorized by this section and formulas
15 for computing the amount of the credit that a business entity may
16 receive in a tax year.

17 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
18 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019.
19 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
20 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
21 legislature to provide for a credit against ad valorem taxes
22 imposed by a school district on the property owned by a business
23 entity that donates money to the district to create or support
24 career and technical education programs or courses."
