A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the legislature
- 2 to enact laws providing for a court to grant a commutation of
- 3 punishment to a person who has successfully served the required
- 4 number of years on parole.
- 5 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 11(a), Article IV, Texas Constitution,
- 7 is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) The Legislature shall by law establish a Board of
- 9 Pardons and Paroles and shall require it to keep record of its
- 10 actions and the reasons for its actions. The Legislature shall have
- 11 authority to enact parole laws, including laws authorizing a court
- 12 to grant a commutation of punishment to a person who has
- 13 <u>successfully served the specified number of years on parole</u>
- 14 <u>required by law,</u> and laws that require or permit courts to inform
- 15 juries about the effect of good conduct time and eligibility for
- 16 parole or mandatory supervision on the period of incarceration
- 17 served by a defendant convicted of a criminal offense.
- 18 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 19 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019.
- 20 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 21 proposition: "The constitutional amendment authorizing the
- 22 legislature to enact laws providing for a court to grant a
- 23 commutation of punishment to a person who has successfully served
- 24 the required number of years on parole."
