## A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment allowing the expenditure of
- 2 motor vehicle fuel taxes and registration fees for passenger rail
- 3 and transit.
- 4 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 7-a, Article VIII, Texas Constitution,
- 6 is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 7-a. Subject to legislative appropriation, allocation
- 8 and direction, all net revenues remaining after payment of all
- 9 refunds allowed by law and expenses of collection derived from
- 10 motor vehicle registration fees, and all taxes, except gross
- 11 production and ad valorem taxes, on motor fuels and lubricants used
- 12 to propel motor vehicles over public roadways, shall be used for the
- 13 sole purpose of acquiring rights-of-way, constructing,
- 14 maintaining, and policing such public roadways, and for the
- 15 administration of such laws as may be prescribed by the Legislature
- 16 pertaining to the supervision of traffic and safety on such roads;
- 17 and for the purpose of constructing, maintaining, and operating
- 18 passenger rail and transit; [and for the payment of the principal
- 19 and interest on county and road district bonds or warrants voted or
- 20 issued prior to January 2, 1939, and declared eligible prior to
- 21 January 2, 1945, for payment out of the County and Road District
- 22 Highway Fund under existing law; provided, however, that
- 23 one-fourth (1/4) of such net revenue from the motor fuel tax shall
- 24 be allocated to the Available School Fund; and, provided, however,

- 1 that the net revenue derived by counties from motor vehicle
- 2 registration fees shall never be less than the maximum amounts
- 3 allowed to be retained by each County and the percentage allowed to
- 4 be retained by each County under the laws in effect on January 1,
- 5 1945. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as authorizing
- 6 the pledging of the State's credit for any purpose.
- 7 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 8 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019.
- 9 The ballot shall be printed to permit voting for or against the
- 10 proposition: "The constitutional amendment to allow the
- 11 expenditure of motor vehicle fuel taxes and registration fees to
- 12 construct, maintain, and operate passenger rail and transit."
