

A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 proposing a constitutional amendment allowing increased
2 distributions to the available school fund.

3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 5(g), Article VII, Texas Constitution,
5 is amended to read as follows:

6 (g) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
7 constitution or of a statute, the State Board of Education, the
8 General Land Office, or another [~~an~~] entity [~~other than the State~~
9 ~~Board of Education~~] that has responsibility for the management of
10 revenues derived from permanent school fund land or other
11 properties may, in its sole discretion and in addition to other
12 distributions authorized under this constitution or a statute,
13 distribute to the available school fund each year revenue derived
14 during that year from the land or properties, not to exceed \$600
15 [~~\$300~~] million by each entity each year.

16 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
17 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019.
18 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
19 proposition: "The constitutional amendment allowing increased
20 distributions to the available school fund."
