A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 proposing a constitutional amendment allowing increased
- 2 distributions to the available school fund.
- 3 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 5, Article VII, Texas Constitution, is
- 5 amended by amending Subsection (g) to read as follows:
- 6 (g) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 7 constitution or of a statute, the General Land Office or an entity
- 8 other than the State Board of Education that has responsibility for
- 9 the management of permanent school fund land or other properties
- 10 may in its sole discretion distribute to the available school fund
- 11 each year revenue derived during that year from the land or
- 12 properties, not to exceed $\frac{$600}{}$ [\$300] million each year.
- 13 SECTION 2. This proposed constitutional amendment shall be
- 14 submitted to the voters at an election to be held November 5, 2019.
- 15 The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or against the
- 16 proposition: "The constitutional amendment allowing increased
- 17 distributions from the available school fund."
