- 1 WHEREAS, Proud residents of Beaumont, Orange, Port Arthur,
- 2 and surrounding communities are gathering in Austin on February
- 3 11-12, 2019, to celebrate Golden Triangle Days at the State
- 4 Capitol; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Situated on the Gulf Coast and western Louisiana
- 6 border, amid low marshland, this region within Jefferson and Orange
- 7 Counties is well known for its rich natural resources; in its early
- 8 years, the area grew as an active riverport that served as a center
- 9 for cattle raisers, farmers, lumber workers, and rice millers; and
- 10 WHEREAS, In 1901, the Spindletop oil gusher was discovered by
- 11 Captain Anthony F. Lucas in Beaumont, and the region transformed
- 12 virtually overnight; the discovery of oil and gas led to a boom in
- 13 industry and wealth, and the area of land between the cities of
- 14 Beaumont, Orange, and Port Arthur was deemed the Golden Triangle;
- 15 and
- 16 WHEREAS, Along with its abundant resources, this dynamic
- 17 region is also known for its strong industrial infrastructure,
- 18 which includes the impressive ports of Beaumont and Port Arthur,
- 19 high-capacity railways, and land-based highways; as a result, the
- 20 Golden Triangle has become one of the largest refining and
- 21 petrochemical hubs in the world, and it is associated with
- 22 world-renowned corporations such as Chevron, ExxonMobil, and
- 23 Texaco; and
- 24 WHEREAS, In recent years, there has been tremendous

- 1 international investment in the region from companies based in
- 2 France, Canada, Austria, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, the United Kingdom,
- 3 and the Netherlands; with an estimated \$54 billion in new
- 4 investment, and a workforce that is committed to increasing
- 5 production capacity, the Beaumont/Orange/Port Arthur area is
- 6 experiencing its lowest unemployment rate in a decade; and
- WHEREAS, The approximately 400,000 residents of the Golden
- 8 Triangle have access to distinguished educational institutions,
- 9 including Lamar University, Lamar State College-Orange, Lamar
- 10 State College-Port Arthur, and the Lamar Institute of Technology;
- 11 the public also benefits from the extraordinary landscape of
- 12 Southeast Texas, which lends itself to various environmental
- 13 tourism sites, such as Shangri La Botanical Gardens and Nature
- 14 Center, the Big Thicket National Preserve, Sea Rim State Park, and
- 15 the McFaddin National Wildlife Refuge; moreover, there are numerous
- 16 historical and cultural attractions, including Beaumont's Crockett
- 17 Street Entertainment District, Spindletop-Gladys City Boomtown
- 18 Museum, McFaddin-Ward House, Sabine Pass Battleground State
- 19 Historic Site, and Museum of the Gulf Coast; and
- 20 WHEREAS, The public-spirited residents of Jefferson and
- 21 Orange Counties are working together to recover from Hurricane
- 22 Harvey and to take advantage of historic development opportunities,
- 23 and it is indeed fitting to honor their dedication and commitment as
- 24 they build a vibrant and prosperous future for their communities
- 25 and the Lone Star State; now, therefore, be it
- 26 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 86th Texas
- 27 Legislature hereby recognize February 11-12, 2019, as Golden
