R E S O L U T I O N

7 bachelor's degree in economics from the University of Houston, and

15 over the years, he has served as a briefing attorney for the Texas
16 Court of Criminal Appeals, an assistant district attorney at the

18 attorney for the Barrett, Burke, Wilson, Castle, Daffin, & Frappier
19 law firm; additionally, he was a municipal prosecutor for the
20 Cities of Meadows Place, Wallis, and Jersey Village, a judge for
21 Jacinto City, and an adjunct professor at Thurgood Marshall School
22 of Law; in 2003, he opened the Middleton Law Firm, where he
23 practiced in the areas of criminal law, civil litigation,
24 bankruptcy, and appeals; and
