1 WHEREAS, Daryl L. Smith has been elected to the office of
2 Fort Bend County constable for Precinct 2, and he is indeed
3 deserving of special recognition; and

4 WHEREAS, Constables are tasked with executing all civil and
5 criminal processes recorded in Fort Bend County and the State of
6 Texas, including civil citations, notices, writs, subpoenas, and
7 criminal arrest warrants; they also receive all misdemeanor arrest
8 warrants from the district attorney's office, and as members of law
9 enforcement, they are called to act on requests for assistance from
10 their constituents; Mr. Smith prevailed in the general election
11 held on November 6, 2018, and as constable for Precinct 2, he
12 presides over an area that includes Missouri City and other
13 communities in the northeastern corner of the county; and
