

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Citizens and business leaders of Dayton are
2 gathering in Austin on February 26, 2019, to celebrate Dayton Day at
3 the State Capitol; and

4 WHEREAS, Situated in southwest Liberty County, with the
5 Trinity River serving as its eastern boundary, Dayton is among the
6 oldest settled areas in the Lone Star State; as the highest point
7 between Houston and New Orleans, it served as a railway flag stop
8 for much of its early history; and

9 WHEREAS, Lumber, cattle, and rice farming were the primary
10 business interests in Dayton before the oil boom of the 1920s; the
11 discovery of oil in Southeast Texas brought rapid development, and
12 while agriculture is still vital to the local economy, jobs in metal
13 fabrication, chemical refining, oil field services, retail, and
14 coiled metal tubing and piping have expanded notably; and

15 WHEREAS, Today, Dayton is home to more than 7,000 Texans; it
16 has an active chamber of commerce whose members are working to
17 enhance the city's overall well-being, and their achievements and
18 commitment are benefiting the economic environment throughout the
19 area; the town's residents and visitors alike can enjoy the
20 Colbert-Rosenwald School and the Dayton Historical Society Old
21 School Museums and take delight in annual events such as the Dayton
22 Ole Tyme Days Festival and the Spirit of Christmas celebration; and

23 WHEREAS, With a colorful history, an abundance of natural
24 resources, and an inviting small-town atmosphere, Dayton is a great
