13 WHEREAS, With the state crown on the line, Newton faced off 14 against Canadian High School; the Eagles took a commanding 21-0 lead into halftime on a pair of touchdown runs from Darwin Barlow 15 16 and an interception return for a score by Kevin Watson; the Canadian squad mounted a furious second-half rally, cutting the deficit to 17 five with a chance for a game-winning touchdown in the final minute, 18 but a goal-line interception by Dominique Seastrunk ended the 19 threat; when the final seconds ticked off the clock, Newton 20 21 recorded a 21-16 triumph and collected its second consecutive state championship and its fifth overall; moreover, under the guidance of 22 23 head coach W. T. Johnston, the Eagles have established a remarkable

30-0 record over the past two seasons; and
