Jandrucko, a former Mansfield ISD educator who was a champion for early childhood education over the course of 34 years with the 6 7 district; hired as a fourth-grade teacher at Alice Ponder Elementary School in 1978, Dr. Jandrucko was later appointed 8 principal at J. L. Boren and Glenn Harmon Elementary Schools before 9 moving into administrative roles at the district level; prior to 10 11 her retirement in 2012, she served as an assistant superintendent 12 of early education and area superintendent; she maintained a career focus on nurturing the potential of the district's youngest 13 14 learners, and the Dr. Sarah K. Jandrucko Academy is the culmination of her longtime support for the creation of a Mansfield ISD 15 16 prekindergarten campus; and

WHEREAS, Designed to improve the academic readiness of young students, the academy aims to promote literacy and numeracy development; the school is centered on research asserting that children learn best through active, exploratory experiences, and it features 16 distinct learning environments; and
