R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Mansfield Independent School District is
2 celebrating the opening of the Dr. Sarah K. Jandrucko Academy for
3 Early Learners with a dedication ceremony on January 26, 2019; and

4 WHEREAS, The new campus is named in honor of Dr. Sarah
5 K. Jandrucko, a former Mansfield ISD educator who was a champion
6 for early childhood education over the course of 34 years with the
7 district; hired as a fourth-grade teacher at Alice Ponder
8 Elementary School in 1978, Dr. Jandrucko was later appointed
9 principal at J. L. Boren and Glenn Harmon Elementary Schools before
10 moving into administrative roles at the district level; prior to
11 her retirement in 2012, she served as an assistant superintendent
12 of early education and area superintendent; she maintained a career
13 focus on nurturing the potential of the district's youngest
14 learners, and the Dr. Sarah K. Jandrucko Academy is the culmination
15 of her longtime support for the creation of a Mansfield ISD
16 prekindergarten campus; and

17 WHEREAS, Designed to improve the academic readiness of young
18 students, the academy aims to promote literacy and numeracy
19 development; the school is centered on research asserting that
20 children learn best through active, exploratory experiences, and it
21 features 16 distinct learning environments; and

22 WHEREAS, A fitting tribute to the contributions of its
23 namesake, the Dr. Sarah K. Jandrucko Academy will equip young
24 Texans with the knowledge and skills necessary to build a brighter

1 future, and it is indeed a welcome addition to the Mansfield
2 Independent School District; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 86th Texas
4 Legislature hereby commemorate the dedication of the Dr. Sarah
5 K. Jandrucko Academy for Early Learners and extend to the school's
6 teachers, staff, and students sincere best wishes for the future;

9 prepared for the school as an expression of high regard by the Texas
10 House of Representatives.
