2 pinnacle of success by winning the 2018 University Interscholastic
3 League 1A state championship on November 15 at the Curtis Culwell
4 Center in Garland; and

6 season, the Lady Tigers advanced through the playoffs with wins
7 over High Island, Oakwood, Avery, and Cumby Miller Grove High
8 Schools to become one of the final four teams in the 1A state
9 tournament; and

11 semifinals, Neches faced off against Water Valley High School in
12 the finale; the Lady Tigers triumphed over their opponents in three
13 straight games, capturing the school's first state volleyball crown

18 roster: Emily Hill, Reagan Gray, Mallory Main, Makenzie Hudson,

20 Rogers, Madison Catchot, Raegan Hill, Morgan Scruggs, and Kacie
21 Kimbrough, who was named the Most Valuable Player of the
22 championship match; the Lady Tigers were ably guided by head coach
23 Morgan Roberson and assistant coach Trent Cook, and they further
24 benefited from the support of manager Gabby Blackmon; and

2 culmination of countless hours of hard work and an unwavering
3 commitment to excellence, and these talented student-athletes will
4 treasure the memory of this accomplishment for the rest of their
5 lives; now, therefore, be it
