1 WHEREAS, For more than 130 years, United Way has raised funds
2 to support agencies in local communities, and the celebration of
3 Texas United Ways Community Day at the State Capitol offers an
4 opportunity to honor this organization for working to better the
5 lives of countless Texans; and

6 WHEREAS, Established in 1887, United Way envisions a world
7 where everyone has an opportunity to succeed and where entire
8 communities thrive as a result; local affiliates build productive
9 relationships among philanthropists, the public sector, and
10 business and nonprofit leaders to identify and implement solutions
