3 WHEREAS, Athens was first incorporated in 1856, and through 4 the decades, this charming East Texas town has seen significant 5 growth; today, its diverse economic base includes industrial 6 manufacturing and other businesses in addition to farming and 7 livestock ventures; education is a key element in the town's 8 productivity, with Trinity Valley Community College and the area's 9 other schools helping residents to prepare for the future; and

10 WHEREAS, The county seat of Henderson County, Athens is home 11 to four wineries and a craft brewery, and it has been called the 12 Black-Eyed Pea Capital of the World for the years when "cowpeas" 13 were a major crop for the local farming community; Athens was also 14 named the Original Home of the Hamburger by the Texas Legislature in 15 tribute to the role that city resident Fletcher Davis played in the 16 creation of this American favorite; and

WHEREAS, Visitors and residents alike enjoy such cultural institutions as the East Texas Arboretum, the Henderson County Historical Museum, the Henderson County Performing Arts Center, the Cain Center, the Henderson County Fairpark Complex, and the Texas Freshwater Fisheries Center, where 300,000 gallons of aquarium exhibits feature a wide variety of native Texas fish in natural environments; and
