RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, A number of proud West Texas citizens are gathering 2 in Austin to celebrate Hudspeth County Day at the State Capitol; and WHEREAS, Created out of El Paso County in 1917, Hudspeth 3 County covers more than 4,500 square miles of the vast Chihuahuan 4 5 Desert, and residents enjoy the area's great natural beauty, sweeping vistas, and friendly, close-knit communities; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Numerous archeological sites in the county attest to the presence of farmers and hunter-gatherers in prehistoric times, 8 and missionaries and soldiers from northern New Spain traversed the 9 area as early as 1581 during the Rodríguez-Sánchez expedition; in 10 11 1849, John S. "Rip" Ford and Major Robert S. Neighbors charted a 12 trail that would be used by many adventurers on their way to the California gold fields; Fort Quitman was established in 1858 on the 13 14 Rio Grande, in the southern part of the present-day county, to protect travelers and mail coaches en route between San Antonio and 15 16 El Paso; and WHEREAS, In 1881, the country's second transcontinental 17 railroad was completed near what is now Sierra Blanca, and Jay Gould 18 drove in a silver spike to mark the occasion; the town of Sierra 19 20 Blanca quickly developed into a shipping point and commercial 21 center, and when the county was organized it became the county seat; homesteaders began settling in the area in the early 20th century, 22 23 and the county later served as a haven for refugees fleeing the upheaval caused during the Mexican Revolution; and 24

- 1 WHEREAS, The economy of Hudspeth County has been based
- 2 chiefly on ranching, farming, and mining, along with tourism and
- 3 hunting leases; a section of the Guadalupe Mountains National Park,
- 4 a destination for outdoors enthusiasts, is located within the
- 5 county, as is part of the Sierra Diablo Wildlife Management Area,
- 6 which is home to the largest population of free-ranging bighorn
- 7 sheep in Texas; in addition, the county is the site of the only
- 8 adobe courthouse in the state; and
- 9 WHEREAS, The citizens of Hudspeth County share a deep
- 10 appreciation for their beloved corner of the Lone Star State, and it
- 11 is indeed fitting to honor them for their achievements and their
- 12 public spirit; now, therefore, be it
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 86th Texas
- 14 Legislature hereby recognize Hudspeth County Day at the State
- 15 Capitol and extend to the visiting delegation sincere best wishes
- 16 for a meaningful and memorable stay in Austin.
