R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The members of Fallbrook Church in Houston are
2 celebrating the 25th anniversary of their church's founding in
3 2019; and

4 WHEREAS, Organized by Pastor Michael Pender Sr., who
5 continues to lead the congregation today, Fallbrook Church held its
6 first service at Gray Elementary School in September 1994; members
7 worshiped in private homes, an office space, and a co-leased church
8 before Fallbrook established its current campus on Walters Road and
9 opened its auxiliary building in 2001; over the succeeding years,
10 the church expanded its facilities to include a community center, a
11 worship center, and a children's and youth building; and

12 WHEREAS, In the quarter century since its founding, Fallbrook
13 has grown into a thriving congregation with more than 10,000
14 members who have launched a variety of commendable programs that
15 foster fellowship and offer help to those in need; committed to
16 supporting children and families, the church also operates a day
17 care, before-school and after-school programs, and a charter school
18 for students in kindergarten through 12th grade; and

19 WHEREAS, Countless Houston residents have looked to
20 Fallbrook Church for spiritual guidance over the years, and it is a
21 pleasure to join in honoring the church at this special time in its
22 rich history; now, therefore, be it
